I Am Walking For My Life

n September, I was diagnosed with Polymyalgia Rheumatic or Lupus the doctor was not sure which one since I had the markers for both. I chose not to claim either and refused to take the drug Prednisone which can cause me more health problems than the disease. The pain in my shoulders and swelling in my hands made it difficult to brush my teeth, hold a glass or even get out of bed because I had no strength in my upper body to pull the covers of my bed back. My wonderful husband Edmond



got busy doing research to find an alternative to help decrease the inflammation and ease my pain. Edmond and I decided to take the Holistic route. I started taking Curcumin or Turmeric supplements, Fish Oil and other natural supplements. My body reacted immediately. I was lucky that my legs and hips are not affected, Since I

walk every day, that has kept me in good shape. I know that if my legs or hips are affected I could end up in a wheelchair, so I walking to save my life.

I also gave up bread, sugar, butter, salt, cheese, anything that causes inflammation. I was amazed at how easy it was to give up those things I used to love (cake, cookies and gelato and any kind of bread). When I think about eating a cookie, or a pastry, I say in my mind, I am eating to save my life, and I don't want that cookie anymore.

The exciting news is, I am experimenting with different recipes. There are wonderful dishes I created without adding any salt or just a pinch of Kosher salt while cooking (never on my food once it is on my plate). I thought I would die without sugar, and last weekend I made candy (with dates). Each morning I blend a smoothie for breakfast with assorted fruits and coconut milk. I eat a mixed green salad

every day prior to eating the main course (I eat less that way).

Snacks are fresh fruits and unsalted roasted nuts like pumpkin, walnuts, sunflower seeds and almonds. I read in our last newsletter that we are putting together an Alford Cook Book. I will very excited to share some of my dishes.

I am sharing my story with my family in the hopes that someone may want to reevaluate the choices they are make regarding the foods they eat and daily exercise. Because we are walking and eating to save our lives.



educated in Wichita public schools. She worked as a bus driver for the City of Wichita, where she later retired. She celebrated her 83rd birthday on April 9.


Memorial services were held on October 20, 2017 at Jackson Mortuary in Wichita, Kansas.
